MEMORANDUM FOR HUMAN RESOURCES COMMAND G-3

**SUBJECT: Fiscal Year 2012 HQDA G-33 Individual Mobilization Augmentee (IMA)
Priority Guidance for Meeting FY12 IMA End Strength Objectives**

1. References.

2. The following Individual Mobilization Augmentee Agency billets are considered high priority fill by HQDA. Agencies are listed in order with highest priority at the top.

- a. U.S. Special Operations Command (283 unfilled out of 428 billets)
- b. U.S. Medical Command (354 unfilled out of 850 billets)
- c. U.S. Army Intelligence and Security Command (70 unfilled out of 151 billets)
- d. U.S. Army Deputy Chiefs of Staff, G-1, G-2, G-3/5/7, and G-4 (104 unfilled out of 288 billets)
- e. U.S. Army Forces Command (62 unfilled out of 119 billets)
- f. Office of the Chief of the Army Reserve (134 unfilled out of 300 billets)
- g. U.S. Army Pacific (54 unfilled out of 126 billets)

SUBJECT: Fiscal Year 2012 HQDA DCS, G-3/5/7 Drilling Individual Mobilization Augmentee (DIMA) Priority Guidance for Meeting DIMA End Strength Objectives

3. HQDA G-33 recommends filling the above IMA billets in order to support current Contingency Operations and meet the IMA end strength objective of 4,000 assigned IMA soldiers. HRC will assign personnel mobilizing against a vacant IMA position to that position. Personnel not qualified to be assigned to the position (e.g, ARNG, MOS/rank mis-match, Retiree Recall) will be approved on a limited case by case basis through DAMO-OD and will only be approved for voluntary CO-ADUS orders.
4. Geographical proximity is an important consideration for CONUS IMA Soldiers. IMA Soldiers within commuting distance can be mobilized without the addition cost of long term TDY funds or PCS funds. In addition, coordination of training and rapid re-call can be accomplished much easier through a local IMA Soldier.
